TBA BREEDERS BADGE SCHEME (BBS) 2012 - 2013

Your current membership of the TBA BBS is only valid until 30th APRIL 2012 and the separate application form must be completed and returned so that your Horseracing Privilege PASS Card(s) can be reactivated for the coming year. *YOUR CARD(S) WILL AUTOMATICALLY DE-ACTIVATE ON THIS DATE SHOULD YOU CHOOSE NOT TO RE-APPLY.*****

On receipt of this application, your breeding details will be processed at the PASS Card Office. Once processed, you will be sent confirmation and any Horseracing Privilege PASS Card(s) that are required.

TERMS & CONDITIONS - TBA/RCA Breeders Badge Scheme (BBS)

The scheme provides complimentary badges to TBA Members on BBS days when a horse they have bred is declared to run. Members of the scheme will have a Horseracing Privilege Photo PASS Card, and their breeding links will automatically be connected to it.

- BBS is administered by the TBA and general queries should be directed to the TBA office

- BBS is included free of charge to fully paid up members of the TBA as an additional benefit of membership.
- Membership of the BBS is renewable annually and runs from **1st May to 30th April**. Breeders whose TBA membership lapses will also lapse their admission through BBS.
- ALL MEMBERS OF THE BBS NEED TO HAVE A **PHOTO PASS CARD**.
- For cards registered under joint or stud/business names a blue Horseracing Privilege Pass Cards is required without a photo.
- The breeding details held on the card need to be updated annually, however, as long as a Photo Pass Card is held then the card does not need to be replaced.
- It is essential that all the relevant information is provided, where possible, to ensure that the correct details are stored on your card(s). Failure to do so could lead to disappointment at the racecourse.
- Applications will only be accepted on this form, available from the TBA.
- Membership is strictly non-transferable.
- Successful applicants will have their Horseracing Privilege PASS Card validated by the PASS Card office at Wellingborough or a new Card despatched to them.
- There are over 1,000 participating fixtures each year, details available on the TBA Website.
- Membership of the BBS entitles complimentary access to the Racecourse for the member plus one guest only at participating racecourses and fixtures, excluding Jockey Club Racecourses.
- Under the 2012 Racecourse Badge Scheme Jockey Club Racecourses (Aintree, Carlisle, Cheltenham, Epsom, Exeter, Haydock Park, Huntingdon, Kempton Park, Market Rasen, Newmarket, Nottingham, Sandown Park, Warwick and Wincanton) will allow complimentary access for 1 person only to all race dates at Jockey Club Racecourses in 2012, excluding Premium Racedays, Festival Race Meetings and Music Nights.
- BBS badges will not apply in addition to the standard allocation of badges given to owners with a runner on a particular day.
- On-course bookmakers are not eligible to apply.
- Entry to each racecourse is subject to the Terms and Conditions of entry at that racecourse.
